- 3. Applicants must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand and reside in Taranaki.
- 4. Applicants must complete the online entry form available through the PowerUp page on the Venture Taranaki website https://www.venture.org.nz/enterprise-and-entrepreneurship/power-up/).
- 5. Applicants may only submit one application.
- 6. The Applicant must be authorised by all partners in the development of the idea or solution to make the application on their behalf and be able to evidence this authority if required by Venture Taranaki Trust.
